Since we do not, often times an extra percentage is coming out of your pocket because you choose to see us. Sometimes this percentage is non-existent, or a minimal 10% decrease in your coverage. We are always willing to work with your specific plan to the best of our ability. That may include pre-estimates, pre authorizations, filing claims, and follow up. However, let me explain some of the details that would separate us from a dentist who might contract with your insurance company.

Our approach to dentistry is holistic in nature. What does that mean?

Dr. Dani has a degree in nutritional sciences and biochemistry from the University of Illinois. She approaches each patient as a whole, exploring and understanding their medical history and coordinating how it relates to their individual dental needs and materials.

Quality materials are essential in this mix. We use BPA free composite fillings, many non-metal substances that are state of the art, CAD-CAM designed, nontoxic, and no amalgamations of mercury, nickel, or palladium. We use a high-quality laboratory technician, who is a master technician making his crowns in the United States. He is also an expert in Anatomy and Physiology of the jaw, combining truly artistic form with accurate function.

We have a sophisticated air filter designed specifically to eliminate dental gases emitted by the cutting of toxic metals in your mouth. We incorporate digital radiography which greatly reduces the exposure of radiation and provides superior detail. We have a special diode laser for treating tissue and bacteria, anesthesia that is free of carcinogenic preservatives, and CAD-CAM technology.

We have a staff that is passionate about dentistry and caring for your dental needs. The state of Illinois requires approximately 16 hours of continuing education per year. Dr. Dani is passionate and committed to staying current with technology and technique. Each year, she averages close to 100 hours of continuing education. This far surpasses the 16 hour requirement of the state of Illinois.
